Interventions for Cancer Prevention in Families at High-Risk for
Hereditary Breast and Ovarian Cancer
(Vortrag auf Englisch)

Dr. Katapodi completed her nursing degree at the University of Athens, Greece (1998) and went for graduate studies at the University of California San Francisco (UCSF) as a Fulbright Scholar. She earned a Master's in Oncology Nursing (2000) and a Doctor of Philosophy in Nursing Science (2004). In 2010 she attended the Summer Genetics Institute, an intensive training program in molecular genetics at the US National Institute of Health. In 2006 Dr. Katapodi was appointed as an Assistant Professor at the University of Michigan, School of Nursing, and was promoted to Associate Professor with tenure in 2013. In 2014 Dr. Katapodi joined INS at the University of Basel.

Her research focuses on cancer screening, communication, and testing in families with genetic mutations that increase the risk for cancer. She has received competitive awards from the U.S. Department of Defence, the Oncology Nursing Foundation, the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, and the U.S. Centres for Disease Control and Prevention to test interventions that help families manage their hereditary cancer risk.
